IN VIEW OF the Notice published by INPS, addressed to Universities and aimed at the selection

of PhD courses, for the academic year 2020-2021, in the field of industry 4.0, statistical and actuarial sciences, sustainable development, INPS and welfare, "for the "disbursement of scholarships for PhD courses in addition to those financed by the MUR and reserved for children and orphans of members of the unitary management of credit and social services and retired users of the management of public employees", whose training proposals presented for PhDs in Humanities and Legal Sciences, due to the health emergency from COVID-19, may be postponed to the A.Y. 2021/2022, as communicated by INPS with PEC prot. No. 129009/2020, and, therefore, additional scholarships funded by INPS may be added to the

aforementioned courses;

IN VIEW OF D.M. No. 156/2021 of 12th February 2021 (published in GU-Serie Generale No. 61 of

12th March 2021) concerning the "Definition of the list of particularly poor countries

for A.Y.2021/2022";

GIVEN THAT positions and scholarships may be increased if additional funding becomes

available from other bodies, including foreign ones, without prejudice to the

deadlines for submitting the application for admission;

WITH RESERVE any subsequent amendments and/or additions to the call that will be advertised

on the website of the University of Messina at the address

http://www.unime.it/it/ricerca/dottorati-ricerca.

DECREES

Art. 1 Institution

The 37th Cycle of PhD Courses with administrative headquarters at the University of Messina (hereinafter referred to as the University) is established, and the relative comparative selections are announced for the admission to the A.Y. 2021/2022 better described in the Attachment to this decree (Attachments No. 1-14).

In the aforementioned Attachments, which form an integral part of the call, are indicated:

- Title of the PhD Course:
- the web pages where the characteristics of the PhD Course are described;
- the positions available with and without scholarship;
- the Industrial PhD positions with a specific obligatory Topic/Project;
- the positions reserved for employees of affiliated Companies (Industrial/Executive PhD)
- any positions reserved for specific categories:
- forms of financial support from research funds or other resources of the University, including research grants;
- the type of qualification required;
- the documents to be attached to the application for the purpose of evaluating the candidates;

- the methods and criteria for the selection and evaluation of candidates;
- the contribution for participation in the competition.

The duration of the PhD courses is three academic years starting from 1st October 2021.

Art. 2 PhD courses in agreement

PhD courses are activated at the University of Messina in agreement with Universities and/or public and private research Bodies, as well as with Institutions and Companies (Industrial PhD), including foreign ones, better described in Attachments No. 1-14.

In the aforementioned Attachments are indicate any reserved positions with a specific obligatory Topic/Project and/or positions of Industrial/Executive PhD, the latter reserved for employees of Companies affiliated with the University and engaged in high-level qualified activities.

The positions linked to the single Topics/Projects, as well as those of Industrial/Executive PhD will be assigned in accordance with the criteria established in attachments No. 1-14 and in the modalities described in the following art. 7.

In particular, without prejudice to the access requirements pursuant to the following art. 3:

✓ <u>for the reserved positions of Industrial/Executive PhD</u>, candidates must certify that they have an employment relationship with the Institution/Company that activated the PhD Course in agreement with the University and that they are committed in highly qualified activities.

The individual agreements regulate the reports, contributions and commitments of the Parties, the organization of the Course, the specific management of financial resources and teaching and instrumental resources made available for each Course.

Art. 3 Admission requirements

The following can participate in the selections, without age and citizenship restrictions:

- a) those who, **at the deadline of the call**, have obtained the specialist degree (D.M. No. 509/1999), or alternatively, the Master's degree diploma (D.M. No. 270/2004), or the degree diploma (old system), or a similar academic qualification, also obtained abroad, and declared equivalent, or recognized as suitable for admission to PhD Courses, based on the principles sanctioned by international conventions on the subject;
- b) or those who **do not meet the above requirement at the deadline of the call**, **provided that** they achieve the qualification required for participation by 31st October 2021, <u>under penalty of forfeiture of admission</u>, in the event of a successful selection.

In the latter hypothesis, candidates who pass the selection tests and enroll in a PhD course, after obtaining the title, and in any case **no later than 31**st **October 2021**, must send to the Rector of the University of Messina (by e-mail at the address protocollo.pec@unime.it or protocollo.geunime.it, or by registered letter with return receipt sent to the address: Piazza Pugliatti, 1 – 98122 Messina), the self-certification relating to the achievement of the qualification together with a valid identification card (or certification, in case of academic qualification obtained in countries not belonging to the European Union), together with the official translation in Italian or English issued by the University that awarded the title indicating:

- ✓ type of title;
- ✓ name of the University that issued the title;
- √ date of graduation;
- ✓ final vote.

Those who, for whatever reason, do not communicate the achievement of the degree within the established terms **will be excluded** from the Courses.

The provisions concerning the access of foreign students to PhD courses academic year 2021/2022 can be consulted by visiting the MUR website (http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri) and institutional website of the University (https://international.unime.it/research/phd-programmes/).

The suitability of the foreign qualification will be ascertained by the PhD examination Committee, for the sole purpose of this selection, in compliance with current legislation, in Italy and in the country where the qualification was issued, and of international treaties or agreements on the subject of recognition of qualifications for the continuation of studies.

All candidates <u>are admitted to the selection conditionally</u> subject to verification of the self certified declarations pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and integrations. At any time of the procedure, even after the start of the PhD courses, the University may carry out checks on the veracity of the statements produced. In the event of false declarations, the University may at any time, with the Rector's provision, order <u>the exclusion</u> of candidates from the selective procedure, or <u>the forfeiture</u> of admission to the PhD Course, without prejudice to the penal responsibilities arising therefrom.

Candidates may apply for admission to several PhD courses, provided that they are given an **option** for only one of them, if they are in a useful position in more than one ranking list.

Art. 4 How to apply

4.1. In accordance with current legislation, the University of Messina has adapted its IT systems through the implementation of **SPID** which represents the authentication system that allows citizens to access the online services of public administrations with a single Digital Identity.

The presentation of the application to participate in the selection, including the documentation indicated in Attachments No. 1-14, takes place electronically through the Esse3 platform https://unime.esse3.cineca.it through:

- Login with SPID for adult candidates;
- Login without SPID for minors and foreign citizens.

The submission of the application for admission through the online procedure implies the acceptance by the candidates of the rules contained in this call including the Attachments No. 1-14, and in the current PhD course Regulations at the University of Messina.

The procedure for participation in the selection will be active for 30 days starting from the day following the online publication of the Call in the University Register at the address http://www.unime.it/it/ateneo/amministrazione/albo-online. After this period, the connection will be deactivated and it will no longer be possible to complete the application form.

Applications received after the indicated deadline, or produced and/or received with a different ways, **will be excluded**.

- **4.2.** In the application, the candidate must declare possession of the requisites for access to the selection referred to in art. 3, in particular <u>EU and non-EU citizens</u> candidates, in possession of foreign qualification(s) obtained in EU and non-EU countries, <u>must attach</u> the qualification certificate(s) possessed (Master's degrees) from which it is deduced:
 - the duration of the study course:
 - the list of exams taken with relative marks (transcript of records);
 - the name of the University that issued the title;
 - the date of achievement and the final grade;

with attached an official translation in Italian or English, **issued by the University that awarded the degree**.

The candidate must also indicate the Course and the Curriculum (where present), for which he/she intends to participate, specifying also the interest and/ or the possession of the requirements for

positions with a specific obligatory Topic/Project and/or for positions reserved for particular categories.

Candidates who wish to participate in the selection for more than one PhD Course must submit an online application for each Course, attaching to each, the documentation required in Attachments No. 1-14.

Candidates must attach, for evaluation purposes, the documents listed in attachments No. 1 - 14 in **PDF format.**

With regard to PhD courses in **Scienze Umanistiche** (Humanistic Sciences) and **Scienze Giuridiche** (Legal Sciences), for which additional positions could be added with scholarships funded by INPS under the **INPS** Call for the academic year 2020/2021, candidates in possession of the additional requirements required by the Institute's announcement, **must self-certify the status of a child or orphan** enrolled in the unitary management of credit and social services or retired users of the Public Employee Management. The assignment of these positions is subject to the positive outcome of the evaluation of the training proposals, presented by the University of Messina, by the special Commission set up at INPS, and the signing of the related financing agreement.

Candidates can make use of self-certifications, according to what is expressly provided for in articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions:

- Italian and EU citizens;
- citizens of countries outside the European Union, legally residing in Italy, <u>limited to</u> status, personal qualities and facts certifiable or attested by Italian public bodies (in particular: Master's degree obtained at an Italian University).

The <u>candidate with disability</u> must specify, in the application form, the necessary aid in relation to his/her disability and any need for additional time, documented by a suitable certificate issued by the Public Health Authority responsible for the area, pursuant to Law No. 104/92, as amended by Law No. 17/99.

The <u>candidate with a diagnosis of specific learning disorders (SLD)</u> must specify, in the application form, the necessary compensatory tools and any need for additional time, documented by a suitable certification issued by no more than three years by NHS Structures, or by specialists and structures accredited by the same, pursuant to Law No. 170/2010 and subsequent guidelines D.M. No. 5669, 12th July 2011.

4.3. At the end of the procedure, the payment of the participation fee of € 50.00 (fifty euro) must be made through the PagoPA® system. The aforementioned payment must be made within the day of expiry of the call.

Only for candidates residing abroad, the payment of the contribution can be made by bank transfer on the IBAN account IT 16W 02008 16511 000300029177 CODE BIC SWIFT UNCRITM1K66 to the attention of the University of Messina, specifying the reason for payment as indicated below "<surname and name of the candidate> contribution for PhD participation in the <denomination of PhD course>".

The obligatory contribution to the competition is <u>not refundable</u> for any reason. The payment receipt must be carefully preserved by the candidate and exhibited in case of request.

Candidates from particularly poor and developing countries defined in the Ministerial Decree No. 156 of the 12th February 2021 **are exempt from the payment of the aforementioned contribution**.

For the academic year 2021/2022, are to be understood particularly poor and developing within the meaning of the aforementioned D.M., the countries listed below:

Art. 5 PhD examination Committees

The examination Committees for admission to the PhD courses are appointed by Decree of the Rector on the proposal of the Academic Board, in compliance with the article No. 11 of the current PhDCourse Regulations at the University of Messina.

In the case of PhD Courses activated in agreement with Italian and foreign external Bodies/Companies, the Committee may be supplemented by the addition of no more than two experts representing these Bodies/Companies.

The aforementioned Decree will be published, after the deadline for the application form has expired, on the University website at the address http://www.unime.it/it/ricerca/dottorati-ricerca with notification value by the University.

Art. 6 Examinations

Admission to PhD courses is by selection, for titles and examinations, according to the modalities and in compliance with the criteria, indicated in Attachments No. 1-14 of this call.

The diary of the tests, with the indication of the day, month and time when they will take place, will be published on the website of the University of Messina at http://www.unime.it/it/ricerca/dottorati-ricerca and will be valid to all intents and purposes as the official convocation of the candidates.

The work of the PhD Committee can be carried out electronically, through the IT platform reachable by accessing the site teams.microsoft.com, virtual classroom "ESAME DI AMMISSIONE AL DOTTORATO IN (EXAMINATION OF ADMISSION PhD COURSE IN) denominazione dottorato (<a href="https://enaminazione.com/php-enaminazione

The PhD examination Committee firstly proceeds with the definition of the sub-evaluation criteria, which will be followed in the assignment of the overall score which will be published on the University website at http://www.unime.it/it/ricerca/dottorati-ricerca.

Subsequently, the Committee evaluates the qualifications presented by the participants, the outcome of which will be visible to each candidate through restricted access to the Esse3 platform.

Candidates may not be present for this evaluation.

Once the evaluation of qualifications is completed, the Committee proceeds to the examination tests according to the methods and in compliance with the criteria indicated for each PhD course in the Attachments No. 1-14 of this call.

The written test, where required, consists of a composition proposed by the Committee aimed at ascertaining the preparation, skills and aptitude for scientific research of the candidates.

The oral test consists of an interview aimed at verifying the knowledge of the candidates on topics that concern the educational and methodological guidelines of the PhD and includes the formal presentation of the proposed research project (where required).

For candidates who have expressed interest in a specific obligatory Topic/Project when applying, the Committee will also express an opinion of suitability with respect to the specific obligatory Topic/Project indicated.

During the interview, knowledge of the language or languages required in the Attachments 1-14 tothis call is checked.

The oral tests can be carried out, according to the indications of the PhD Examination Committees, electronically via the Microsoft Teams IT platform (teams.microsoft.com), virtual classroom ESAME DI AMMISSIONE AL DOTTORATO IN <denominazione dottorato> XXXVI CICLO" ("ADMISSION TO THE PhD EXAMINATION IN <denomination of PhD course > 37th CYCLE") and by connecting to the addresses indicated in the diary of the tests.

Oral tests are public.

The candidate will have to guarantee the use of a webcam to allow his/her identification to the PhD Examination Committee.

Before the interview begins, **under penalty of exclusion from the competition**, the candidate must identify himself/herself by showing a valid identity document, preferably the same one that was uploaded on Esse3 during the presentation of the admission application.

The candidate who is unavailable or does not appear on the day or time set for the interview **must be considered as having renounced**.

The University declines any responsibility for the eventuality that technical reasons prevent the regular conduct of the interview.

The final score of the selection, expressed in hundredths, is given by the sum of the marks reported in the individual assessments (qualifications and exams).

The outcome of the individual assessments, for each candidate, will be published in the restricted access area of the Esse3 system (https://unime.esse3.cineca.it).

At the end of the selection, on the basis of the scores obtained in the evaluation of the qualifications and in the exam tests, the Committee compiles the **general merit ranking** with the list of admitted and not admitted candidates for the PhD Course, including the assessment of suitability for the candidates who in the application have expressed interest in a specific obligatory Topic/Project.

All the PhD Examination Committees must complete the works no later than 15th September 2020.

The general merit ranking list is issued with Decree of the Rector, and is published on the University website with legal notification value to all intents and purposes.

Art. 7 Admission to PhD courses

Candidates are admitted to PhD courses, according to the ranking order and taking into account the suitability expressed by the PhD Committee for the individual obligatory Topics/Projects, up to the number of available positions for the competition.

For the positions with scholarship, with equal merit, the assessment of the most difficult economic situation determined under the current legislation, and in case of further equality, prevails the youngest candidate of age, pursuant to the provisions of art. 17 of the University Regulations.

For positions without scholarship, preference shall be given to the youngest candidate of the same age.

Candidates who are holders of research grants may be admitted, after passing the selection tests, and subject to the provisions of art. 20, point 10 of the University Regulations.

Public employees may be admitted, after passing the selection tests, in accordance with the provisions of art. 20 of the aforementioned Regulation.

Art. 8 Enrollment Procedures

Candidates admitted to the PhD courses, with or without scholarship, must enroll within the **peremptory deadline of 10 days** from publication of D.R. (Decree of Rector) of the final ranking list on the website http://www.unime.it/it/ricerca/dottorati-ricerca. **No personal communications will be sent to candidates. Candidates admitted to the PhD courses are responsible for checking the dates and enrollment procedures.**

Candidate who participated and ranked successfully in more than one selection procedure, must proceed with enrollment by exercising the right of option for one of the PhD courses within 10 days of the publication of the final rankings of all the PhD courses to which he/she is admitted. Failure to complete the enrollment in the chosen course by the deadline, will result in the forfeiture of admission to all PhD courses in which the candidate has been admitted.

Simultaneous enrollment in more than one PhD course is not allowed, without prejudice to the provisions of Article 9 of the Regulations.

Candidates must use the enrollment procedure arranged by the Administration, available on the website https://unime.esse3.cineca.it.

The enrollment procedure must be completed within the prescribed deadline, **under penalty of exclusion.**

<u>Candidates in possession of a foreign academic qualification</u> (Master's degree) obtained in EU countries must attach to the application form:

certificate(s) of the qualification(s) possessed with attached an official translation, in Italian or English, **issued by the University that awarded the qualification**.

<u>Candidates in possession of a foreign academic qualification obtained in non-EU countries</u> must attach to the application form:

- a) certificate(s) of the qualification(s) possessed (Master's degrees) with an attached translation, in Italian or English, declared compliant with the text by the Italian competent diplomatic or consular representatives abroad;
- b) Dichiarazione di valore in loco issued by the Italian competent diplomatic or consular representations abroad, certifying the duration of the study program together with the list of exams taken with the relative marks and the academic value of the qualification in the country that issued it

Candidates in possession of a qualification obtained abroad, who do not produce the required documentation at the time of enrollment, will be <u>enrolled with reserve</u> and **will be excluded** from the PhD course, if they fail to deliver such documentation within **six months** from the beginning. of the course and/or following verification, if the title produced does not comply with the requirements of this call.

Foreign candidates, who need a visa to stay in Italy, must register on the portal https://www.universitaly.it, apply for pre-enrollment in the PhD course and follow the procedure indicated therein for the purpose of issuing the visa.

Non-EU citizens must also produce a copy of a regular residence permit within 10 days of issue.

The insertion of untruthful data in the application form will result in exclusion from the final ranking list and the office forfeiture. In this case, the University Administration has the right to recover any benefit granted. The mendacious declaration, in addition to the prescribed penalties, may entail, for the subject involved, actions for compensation of damages by the counter-parties concerned.

Art. 9 Scrolling of ranking and taking over

In the event of forfeiture or waiver, expressed or tacit, by admitted candidates, the final ranking list will be scrolled down for positively evaluated candidates who follow, within three months by the beginning of the Course.

In the event of forfeiture or waiver, expressed or tacit, by admitted candidates for a position linked to a specific obligatory Topic/Project, the scrolling will take place according to the general merit ranking, also taking into account the eligibility expressed by the Committee for the specific obligatory Topic/Project.

The suitable candidate, usefully placed in the ranking, will be sent the scrolling notification via e-mail

Within the **peremptory term of three days** from the communication, the candidate must explicitly and unequivocally express his/her will regarding the scrolling of the ranking list in his/her favor, by communication to be sent to the University at the address protocollo@unime.it.

After this period, the candidate will be considered <u>renouncer</u>.

Candidate who expressed his/her consent to take over the ranking list, must enroll within maximum **10 days** from the publication of the decree of scrolling.

Art. 10 Taxes and fees

The contributory requirements for enrollment and registration to PhD Courses are established with resolutions of the Academic Senate and of the Board of Directors of 27th June 2019.

At the time of enrollment, admitted candidate, Italian and foreign, both with scholarship and without scholarship, is required to pay through the PagoPA® system the amount of \in 156,00 (equal to \in 140,00 regional tax and \in 16,00 virtual stamp).

Admitted candidates, <u>not beneficiaries of scholarship</u>, are exempted from paying fees in favor of the University.

Admitted candidates, <u>beneficiaries of scholarship or of other financial support</u>, are required to pay, for each year of the PhD course, an all-inclusive contribution quantified according to the ISEE income classes generally defined for student's contribution.

At the beginning of each PhD course year following the first one, the PhD student admitted to attend the following year must renew the enrollment within 30^{th} November, using the procedure available at this link https://unime.esse3.cineca.it. After this deadline, the PhD student can enroll, from the 1^{st} to the 31^{st} December, paying a penalty tax of $\in 50,00$ for late payment.

At the time of enrollment/registration, the PhD student beneficiary of a scholarship **must** express his/her consent to the acquisition of "*ISEE Dottorato*" by the University. Otherwise, he/she will be placed in the highest income bracket.

The request to issue the "ISEE Dottorato" certificate must be made at the CAF or other appointed subjects, preferably before enrollment/registration and, in any case, no later than the $31^{\rm st}$ December. In the case of applications for the issue of the "ISEE Dottorato" certificate after that date, the PhD student will be required to pay a revision tax equal to \in 100,00.

The amount of the PhD all-inclusive annual contribution is calculated based on the acquisition of "ISEE Dottorato" through the INPS Application Cooperation system and must be paid, as prescribed by the PagoPA® system, respecting the following deadlines (according to the choice made by the PhD student during the enrollment/registration):

- No. 1 single installment: by 31st March;
- No. 3 installments: by 31st January, 31st March and 31st May.

The penalty fee for late payment of the single deadlines is \leq 28,00.

Admitted foreign candidates (belonging or not to the European Union), beneficiaries of a scholarship, non-resident and not producing income in Italy, are required to pay a PhD single annual all inclusive contribution of € 750,00.

Total or partial exemption from the payment of taxes and fees is established by the "Regulations on student's contributions" and in particular by articles 2 and 6 and by each and every other relevant normative provision.

Art. 11 Incompatibility

The candidates admitted to the PhD courses who are already enrolled in other courses incompatible according to the article 19 of the University Regulations, must require to temporarily suspend their career at the time of enrollment in the PhD course.

PhD Students enrolled in Specialization Schools are also required to temporarily suspend their career, except in the cases referred to in the before mentioned University Regulations.

Art.12 Scholarships

The PhD scholarships are annual and renewed following specific verification by the PhD Academic Board about the completion of the program of the activities planned for the previous year, as well as the evaluation of the research activity carried out,, subject to the obligation to provide the scholarship afterpassing the verification.

The principles referred to in this article do not apply to fellows from foreign countries or beneficiaries of financial support in the context of specific mobility programs, in relation to the provisions of the specific regulations.

The annual amount of the scholarship, paid in monthly deferred installments, is equal to 15.343,28, *gross* of social security contributions paid by the PhD student.

If the PhD student is authorized by the PhD Academic Board to carry out research activities abroad, for a period of not less than 15 days, the amount of the scholarship is increased by 50%, for a period not exceeding 18 months.

Requests for study abroad, duly authorized by the Academic PhD Academic Board, indicating the location, period and motivation, must be sent by the PhD Coordinator of the PhD course to the competent Office at least **30 days before** the beginning of the stay abroad, in order to prepare the subsequent D.R. of increase.

Starting from the second year, it is provided a fund for research activities in Italy and abroad according to the provisions of the article 17 of the Regulations.

In case of waiver or exclusion from the PhD course of a PhD student with a scholarship, he/she will forfeits the right to use the scholarship for the part not accrued.

The PhD student, who intends to renounce the scholarship at the time of admission to the course, must give formal notice to the Rector.

In this case, the PhD student, while maintaining his/her status, loses all right to use the scholarship and the entire scholarship or the accrued quota can be attributed, in the same terms and with the same methods, to the first of PhD students without scholarship, starting from the moment of waiver and the subsequent assignment.

The scholarship **cannot be combined** with any other scholarship, except for those granted by Italian or foreign institutions useful for integrating the PhD student's research activity with stays abroad, with the exclusion of the advanced training activities provided by the Law 398/1989. The PhD scholarship is subject to the payment of social security contributions INPS "Gestione Separata" in accordance with current legislation, of which two thirds shall be borne by the administration and one third by the PhD student with scholarship.

Positions with scholarships referred to in this call may be increased and/or financed following further available funds, obtained:

- by public or private Institutions, also foreign, through agreements or conventions stipulated after the issuing of this announcement;

Art. 13 Attendance, suspension, forfeiture and waiver

In case of **waiver** to continue the PhD course, the interested party is required to **promptly** notify to the PhD Coordinator and the Rector. The disbursement of any scholarship is maintained until the date of waiver.

Art. 14 Processing of personal data
